Where the Parent Member is of More than 5 years standing:

At Time of Application:

- Rs.**100,000** (Being 20% of total Entrance Fee of Rs.5,00,000 i.e. **40%** of 12,50,000/-)
- Rs.10,000 (Annual Subscription);
- Rs.50,000 (Refundable Deposit).

The balance 80% of the Entrance Fee (being **Rs.4,00,000**) will be paid in equal instalments beginning from 1st April thereafter upto 18 years.

Where the Parent Member is of Less than 5 years standing:

At Time of Application:

- Rs.**1,87,500** (Being 20% of total Entrance Fee of Rs.9,37,500/- i.e. **75%** of 12,50,000)
- Rs.10,000 (Annual Subscription);
- Rs.50,000 (Refundable Deposit).

The balance 80% of the Entrance Fee (being **Rs.7,50,000**) will be paid in equal instalments beginning from 1st April thereafter upto the child attaining the age of 18 years.

Where the Junior Member has more than 5 years of standing: At the Time of Application:

- Rs.1,00,000 (being 20% of the total Entrance Fee of Rs.5,00,000 i.e. 40% of 12,50,000/-)
- Rs.10,000 (Annual Subscription)
- Deposit: Difference between deposit already paid and payable.

Balance Payment:

- Rs.4,00,000 (remaining 80%) to be paid in equal instalments beginning from 1st April thereafter, up to the child attaining the age of 18 years.

Where the Junior Member has less than 5 years of standing: At the Time of Application:

- Rs.1,62,500 (Being 20% of the total Entrance Fee of Rs.8,12,500/- i.e. 65% of 12,50,000/-)
- Rs.10,000 (Annual Subscription)
- Deposit: Difference between deposit already paid and payable.

Balance Payment:

- Rs.6,50,000 (remaining 80%) to be paid in equal instalments beginning from 1st April thereafter, up to the child attaining the age of 18 years.

NOTE FOR STAGGERED PAYMENT MEMBERSHIP: - i) In case of any revision in Associate Membership Entrance fee by the Managing Committee, 20% of the difference increased amount will become payable and the instalments will be recalculated and intimated accordingly.

ii) Failure to make deferred or 50% balance payments will result in the forfeiture of the application payment.

~ **HOW TO APPLY FOR NEW MEMBERSHIP** ~

Application forms are available at the club office. Forms should be filled and submitted within 3 month from the date of issue, duly proposed and seconded by 2 members who shall have been Patrons/Life/Ordinary/Associate (who are not members of the Managing Committee). If the Managing Committee member knows the prospective member he can put his information in the reference details and the form can be Proposed and Seconded by other Members with the length of time known as 'Just Met'.

The Proposer and Secunder must be a member for a minimum period of 3 years while signing the application membership form. Temporary/Service/Expatriate members wishing to become members of the club need not necessarily know the Proposer or Secunder for the minimum period stipulated. Either the Proposer or the Secunder **MUST** accompany the candidate at the time of interview.

Foreigners wishing to take Membership of the Club will forward their application duly signed by their Employers / Head of Department. The same rule is also applicable to Service membership.

The application form must be accompanied by the requisite fee as stated above preferably by cheque which will be considered as Earnest Money. On acceptance of the applicant as a member by the Committee, after a Sub-Committee interview, the earnest money will be treated as entrance fee.

In case an applicant is not found acceptable by the Managing Committee, the earnest money will be refunded. In such an event the amount of the bill for the club's facility enjoyed by the applicant in the meanwhile, will be deducted from the amount paid, at the prevailing rate as charged for the guests and the balance amount if any, will be refunded.

Candidate for membership to the club who have paid the requisite fees with the application are entitled to commence riding immediately afterwards, if so desired, pending acceptance of their membership.

Riding age for enrolment of a member is **7 years of age and above.**

~ **NOTES** ~

1. Advance 14 minimum rides are charged to all members as on 1st April each year along with annual subscription. This amount will be credited towards the first 14 rides.
2. Members are allowed to introduce **Guest** not more than **6 times** in a calendar month by the same or different members at the **Riding Ground/Club House.**
3. Horse Owner Members/Senior Citizens are exempted from minimum rides.
4. Life/Patron Members are exempted from annual subscription.
5. Senior Citizens will also enjoy concession in riding rates which will be **50% of the prevailing riding rate.** Annual Subscription in their cases is 1,200/- per annum.

6. Membership is not **TRANSFERABLE** from one member of the family to another. It can however be transferred from one spouse to another in case of death provided the member had a standing of 10 years and above.
7. Member's children (daughter & son) can avail of a family membership up to 18 years of age only.
8. Annual Subscription falls due on 1st April of each year payable within 60 days after which interest is chargeable @ 2%.
9. Taxes as applicable.

Note: During the RACING SEASON, from November to April, there will be No riding on Race Day evenings and Monday mornings. From May to October, there will be NO riding on Mondays.

~ **RULES OF RIDING** ~

1. Every Member can request for a particular horse he/she wishes to ride on the Booking Chart at the Riding ground, subject to the horse not being already booked by a Member. **Booking by PROXY will not be permitted.** Booking is to be made for one ride at a time.

2. Members must sign the Riding Register after the ride is over.
3. **DRESS AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:** Members and Guests must ride in proper riding gear consisting of Breeches or fitted Jeans, Boots or closed leather shoes with plain leather soles with heels, Polo hat/ or a Riding Cap/ Safety helmet.
4. Members and Guests riding club's horses do so at their own risk. **THE CLUB WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS, INJURY OR DAMAGE CAUSED TO THEM DUE TO ANY REASON WHATSOEVER.**
5. A RIDE in all cases will mean 2 slow rounds of the Race Course or 30 minutes of slow schooling in the riding school, whichever is shorter. One riding round is considered equivalent to 15 minutes of slow schooling.
6. **REVERSE GRASS TRACK:** Riding on the race course will be on the reverse GRASS TRACK in an anti-clockwise direction only. The adjacent road should be left clear for the use of the pedestrians. **ONLY Trotting or slow Cantering will be permitted.** Fast Canters and galloping are strictly prohibited on the reverse track. Whilst riding and overtaking other horses and pedestrians, members and guests will be required to slow down in a single file, making sure that no disturbance is caused to those that are being overtaken. The last 50 yards of the round should be taken preferably at a **walk or trot & not at canter.**
7. No riding will be permitted on the polo ground, except for polo practice chukkars during the specified hours, on dates notified by the club's office. Members can ride along the periphery.
8. Members will take special care that they do not disturb the children / beginners while riding in the middle school. Fast polo work on ponies is not allowed in this school.
9. **CHILDREN and BEGINNERS** must proceed slowly and carefully. They will be led by an Escort till confident and able to ride independently. Further coaching is provided as per their progress.
10. Jumping, Tent Pegging, Polo practice and Race Riding will be carried out exclusively when organized by the club and under the supervision of trained instructors.
11. (a) Members introducing Guests will be held responsible in the event of the guest violating any of the above mentioned rules. It will be the sole responsibility of the member to acquaint his/her guest of the above rules of riding.
(b) Professional Riders should not be introduced as Guests.
(c) All fees of a Members' guest will be recoverable from the members only.
(d) A Guest can be introduced for riding at the Riding School and Club House not more than **SIX TIMES** in a Calendar month by the same or different Members. Also if the same guests come to the clubhouse after riding separate guest charges will not be levied again.

12. **OTHER FACILITIES AVAILABLE:**

Stabling facilities: The Club offers stabling facilities to its members intending to own their own horses. An application form to be filled in and submitted at the Club's office along with an initial deposit of Rs.30,000/- with details of the horse. Stables will be allotted according to Stabling Byelaws as & when available.

13. **CLUB HOUSE**: The timing of the Club House is as follows:
- Monday to Sunday - Morning - 07.00 am to 11.00 am
- Monday to Thursday - Evening - 04.00 pm to 11.00 pm
- Friday to Sunday - Evening - 04.00 pm to 11.30 pm

14. **SERVICES**: Riding hats are subject to available at the Club Tack shop.

15. **OFFICE HOURS**: Monday to Friday 9.00 am to 1.00 pm & 1.30 pm to 5.30 pm
Saturdays 9.00 am to 1.00 pm
